

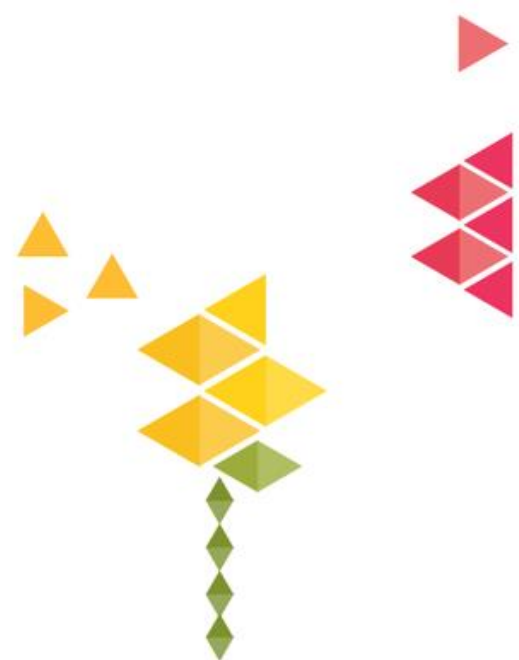

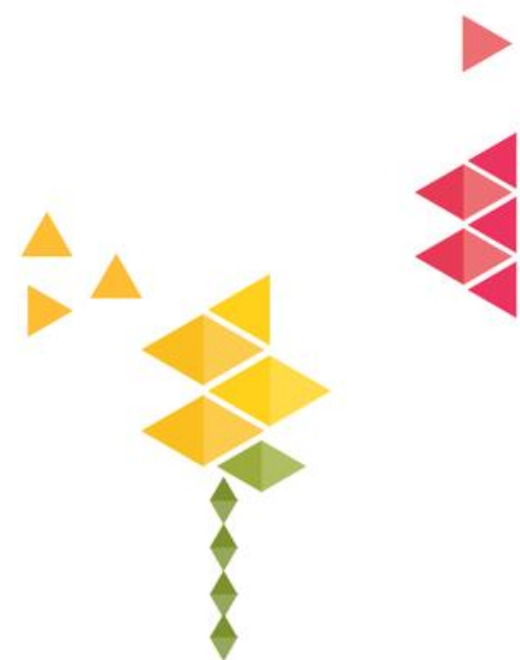

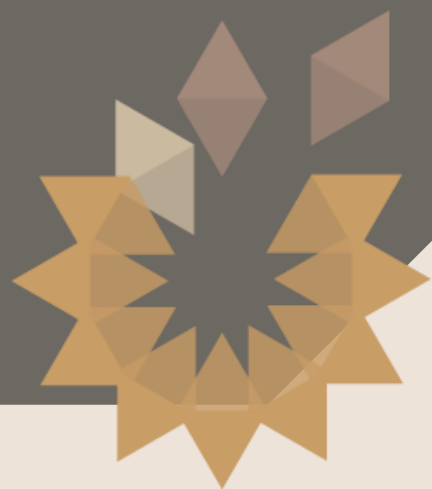

# Arguments pour la sauvegarde de la biodiversité

Il existe de nombreuses bonnes raisons pour lesquelles les gens accordent de l'importance à la biodiversité. 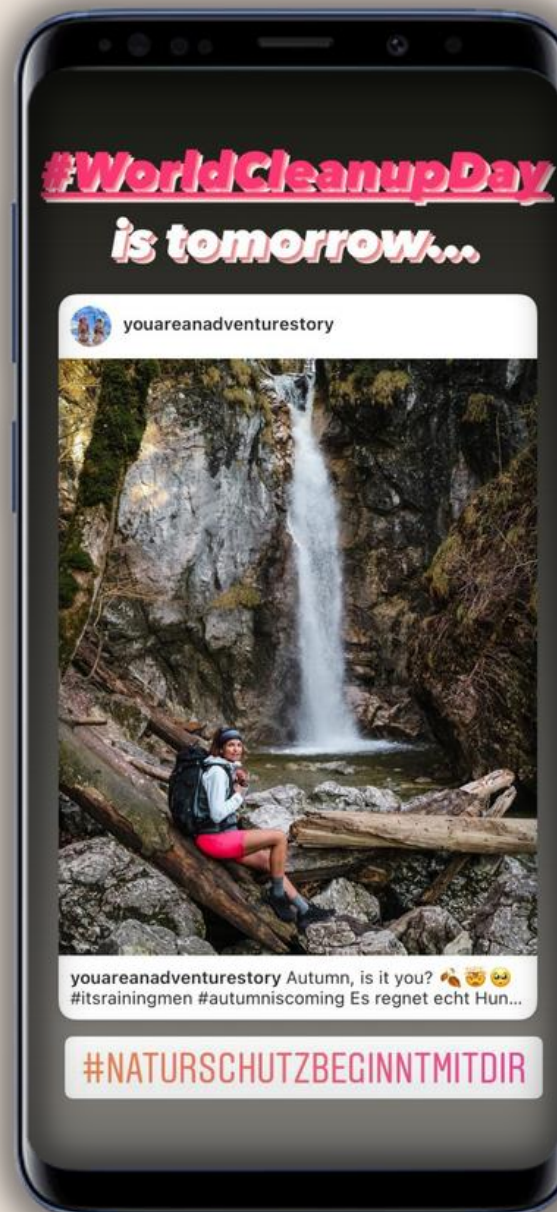
